3. ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

The school's Admissions Criteria are as follows:-

1. Looked after children and all previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted". Previously looked after children are children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangement order or special guardianship order)
2. Children for whom there are exceptional medical/personal/domestic circumstances
3. Children with brothers and sisters (siblings) in school and who will still be attending the school at the time of admission
4. Children of parents with firm connections with supporting churches which include; St Michael and All Angels, Macclesfield,
5. Children living nearest to the school measured using an Ordnance Survey address-point system which measures straight line distances in miles from the address point of the school to the address point of the place of residence, with those living closer to the school receiving higher priority.

Notes

- (a) Siblings include step, half, foster, adopted brothers and sisters living at the same address and full brother and sister living apart.
- (b) By 'firm connections' we mean attendance at a minimum of one service per month for at least six months prior to the closing date for applications. A letter from the incumbent, minister or other church official will be required in support of this.
- (c) Professional supporting evidence (e.g. from a social worker, health visitor, etc.) will be required in order to define 'exceptional personal/domestic circumstances' and why this school is the most appropriate school.
- (d) Where the above criteria are not adequate to distinguish between requests for admission which cannot all be accepted without exceeding the admission limit, priority will be decided on the basis of pupils living nearest to the school measured using an Ordnance Survey address-point system which measures straight line distances in miles from the address point of the school to the address point of the place of residence, with those living closer to the school receiving higher priority. In the event of a tie-break a paper draw will be undertaken by an independent body.
- (e) All children with birthdays between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019 are admitted into Reception in September. For children with a birthday after Christmas or after Easter parents may defer entry until later in the year and the Headteacher should be consulted if this option is being considered.
- (f) A parent is any person who has parental responsibility or care of the child. Where admission arrangements refer to 'parent's attendance at church' it is sufficient for just one parent to attend.
